

Next comes the Valencia County Fair Parade on August 10th and this year's theme is Dr. Seuss: Oh the Places






Facebook camps are major hit with students

Recently, the campus wrapped up its second Valencia Technology Camp. There are five camps, which are funded by a Community Action Facebook grant.

Four of the five camps were dedicated to middle and high school students, while

the Solar Technology camp is geared toward adults. There's a 20-participant limit and \$10 fee for each.

"UNM-Valencia has always been interested in promoting education for all the members of our community. With our strong STEM programs, when we heard about the Facebook grants, we knew that we could use the funding to offer creative



summer programming in technology for the youth of the county," said Laura Musselwhite, Dean of Instruction. "Facebook proved to be the perfect partner to bring such innovative topics as the Internet of Things and Cyber Security to our campus."

The first camp, *Coding*, gave students a hands-on experience with the basic skills needed to write apps for mobile devices. Students got the opportunity to create visual interfaces, respond to user input and apply program logic in the language



used for Apple devices. The June 10-13 camp was instructed by Nancy McLendon.

The second camp, *Internet of Things*, covered the basics of PC networking, the Internet and programmable devices. The labs covered connecting devices such as cameras, sensors, locks, thermostats, wi-fi, switches and thermostats to home networks and the Internet. The June 24-27 camp was led by instructor James Hart.

Workforce Training Center gets Senate's signature of approval

UNM-Valencia is building to better serve the community with higher education. On April 3, New Mexico Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham signed Senate Bill 163, paving the way for the new Workforce Training Center (WTC).

The signing of SB 163 allows the Board of Regents of The University of New Mexico to authorize the creation of an off-campus instructional center in Valencia County.

The WTC has been in the works for more than four years, and now is in the planning and development



stages. When completed, the WTC will be on Huning Ranch Rd, South of Lonestar Street as an approximately 18,000 square foot building along with land graciously donated by the Huning Limited Partnership.

Target completion date will be in Summer 2021.

The building will consist of classrooms, computer labs and the Small Business Development Center, all to provide a flexible environment responsive to the needs of the community and local businesses.

With the population growth, and economic boom in Los Lunas, UNM-Valencia's WTC will help effectively and productively train the local workforce to meet the demands of growing industries.

"The WTC will allow UNM-Valencia to grow its enrollment, serve its community and bolster the burgeoning economic engine by preparing residents with the professional and technical skills to meet employers' needs today and into the future," said Dr. Alice Letteney, Chief Executive Officer.

Campus adds agricultural course to Fall Semester schedule lineup

After receiving multiple requests over the years for more courses in agriculture, UNM-Valencia is trying to help support the rural economy, farmers and ranchers by doing just that.

The campus is now offering a new class, Introduction to Agricultural Economics and Business, for the first time this Fall semester (classes begin August 19).

This course is an orientation to agricultural economics and business for the consumer and small business person. Students will learn about how food, fiber and

natural resources fit into the global economy.

"Agriculture is a significant part of our local, state and national economy," said course instructor Newt McCarty, an agriculture agent for the County Extension Service. "This course can help people gain an understanding of the vast agriculture industry through interaction with farmers,



ranchers, and business owners, and learn how decisions made locally, nationally, and internationally affect the agriculture industry and our economy."

This will be a great classroom experience if the student is involved in 4-H programs, or the Future Farmers of America organization. If a student is still in high school, he or she could take this class as concurrent enrollment.

These credits will transfer to New Mexico State University as a part of an agricultural degree program. UNM-Valencia has an articulation agreement with NMSU to guide students in choosing a four-year program related to agriculture.

"Because we serve a more rural area, it is an exciting opportunity to be able to provide agricultural education," said Dr. Laura Musselwhite, Dean of Instruction. For more information, call the Academic Affairs office at 505.925.8600.
