### Project Manager's Update Ted Hodoba

Spring is just around the corner. The Sandhill Cranes are fewer and fewer at Whitfield as they have begun their migration north. As the winter migrants leave, the spring and summer migrants will soon be arriving. Already, the **Verdins** have begun nest building and the male Red-Winged Blackbirds are staking out nesting territories around

the pond at Whitfield.



Work is finishing up on the interior of the maintenance building at Whitfield. For years all we had was an empty building shell that we have used for storing equipment. With additional Capital Outlay funding from the New Mexico State Legislature, we are now completing the project. Offices, a bathroom, and storage space are being created in a series of rooms including a second story storage area. A state of the art water harvesting and purification system is being installed that will supply the water needs of the staff and their work.

We were fortunate on February 15<sup>th</sup> to showcase Whitfield to Congresswoman Xochitl Torres-Small. She seemed favorably impressed with our efforts here at Whitfield.

Working at Whitfield has been a very rewarding experience for me. I have seen the changes in habitats as we planted thousands of native trees, shrubs, wildflowers, and cacti as well as created wetlands. Along with this, has been the increasing diversity of wildlife especially birds of which we have seen over half of the 400 or so species native to New Mexico. Soon, however, it will be time for me to leave as I am retiring at the end of May this year. I'd like to thank the Friends for their support over the years and hope you continue to make Whitfield the wonderful place it has become.
