THANK YOU BELEN! ☺ State officials kept telling us to prepare for a 25% decline in city revenue and to prepare for deep budget cuts. But because you [#shoplocal](#) we've seen the opposite, nearly a 40% increase in city revenue.

Our April gross receipts tax revenue (GRTs), in the middle of the economic shutdown, and which gets reported two months after collection now in June, showed revenue at \$746,446. Last year in April our GRT was approx. \$449,000.
