





Loan Fund reaches \$100 Million in loans to New Mexico businesses

Continuing to reach milestones, The Loan Fund has made over \$100 million in loans to New Mexico's financially underserved small businesses, entrepreneurs and nonprofits in the past three decades of existence. Since 1989, the nonprofit has been providing loans and lines of credit to small businesses, startups, and nonprofits throughout New Mexico that typically are unable to obtain financing through traditional lending sources.

"Our goal is to answer the question: How do we help fuel the small entrepreneur, the tortilla makers, the day care centers, the embroidery shops, and the small electrician who wants to provide service to his community on the reservation? We do this by offering more than a loan with flexible payment options, we offer technical assistance and financial literacy so that each individual or partnership succeeds," said F. Leroy Pacheco, CEO/President.

Just since January, The Loan Fund has awarded 67 loans, and of those, 44 loans went to minority owned-business, Pacheco said.

In its 31 years, the organization has also helped create over 11,500 jobs across the state.




